


It's estimated that about 1 in 5 homeowners and nearly half of renters in rural areas of New York state are spending more than 30% of their income on housing.

RURAL COUNTIES' HOME PRICES




Rural counties across New York state saw the median sale price of homes rise from 8% to 42% between 2019 and 2021.

TRANSPORTATION



Most rural areas of New York State have limited or no public transit services, while access to demand-response transportation (DRT) options such as taxis and app-based ride-hailing services is often spotty or non-existent.



NYSOFA works with aging agencies in 59 counties and 1,200 community-based organizations that provide services for older adults. In 2021, those entities combined to provide 862,000 rides for older residents, with more than half—an estimated
445,296—provided in rural communities across the state, according to Greg Olsen (NYSOFA).
