REMOTE WORK ACCESS:

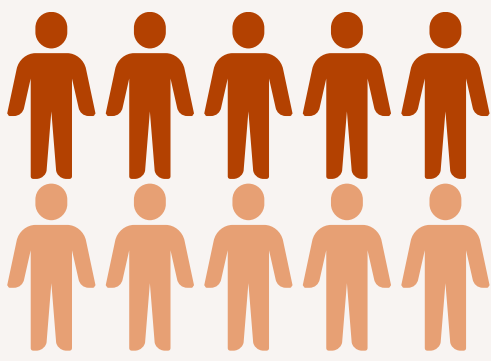
88%

FULLY REMOTE JOBS:

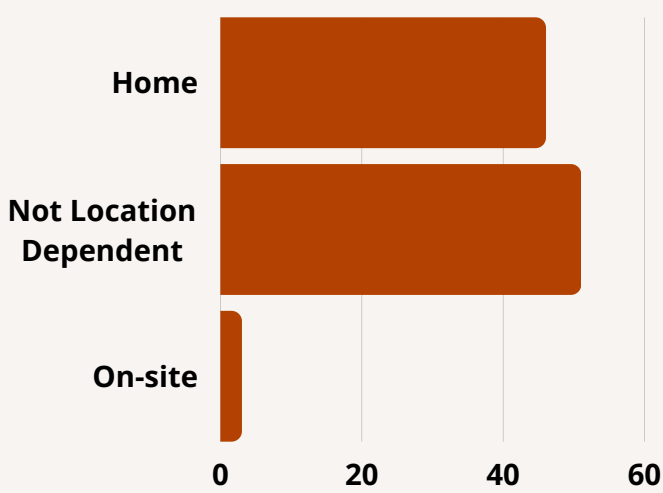
73%

WHERE WORKERS ARE MOST PRODUCTIVE:

Proponents of on-site-only work arrangements say remote workers are not as productive as their in-office counterparts, but only 3% of workers say they are most productive working on-site.
