FINAL ORDER AND JUDGMENT

This matter came before the court for a duly noticed non-jury trial on March 23, 2022. Plaintiff Sabrina Miller appeared at trial; Defendant Ronald Food Market, LLC (“Market”) failed to appear, failed to contact the court, and had not been excused from appearing. Having considered the entire record and the testimony and other evidence adduced at trial, the court finds that Miller is entitled to a final judgment against Market in the amount of \$1,000,000.00 and costs of \$222.00. Miller shall be entitled to post-judgment interest as allowed by law.

On March 24, 2022, Miller filed a dismissal without prejudice as to Defendant Constance Mason, which the court construes as a motion to dismiss. No party objected to Miller’s motion. Having considered the entire record, the court finds that Miller’s motion is due to be, and is hereby, **GRANTED**. “Parties may be dropped or added by order of the court on motion of any party or of its own initiative at any stage of the action and on such terms as are just.” O.C.G.A. § 9-11-21. Mason is dismissed from this lawsuit without prejudice.

This constitutes a final entry of judgment, and the Clerk is authorized to close the case pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 9-11-58(b).
