Beadwork as Inspiration

Beadwork is an art form that has existed since prehistoric times and has shown up in almost every culture since — from Ancient Africa, Ancient Egypt, to the Greeks and Romans, and also the First Peoples. Beadwork is a powerful and relevant metaphor for the confluence and diversity that are central to Calgary's identity. Small individual elements of varying shapes and sizes, colours, and compositions come together to create a stronger whole. In turn, the city's identity is reflective of all Calgarians.

Colour Palette

Calgary's visual identity retains our city's iconic red, a tribute to several key elements of the city's fabric such as the Peace Bridge, Calgary Tower, Calgary Stampede and Calgary's sports teams (including the Calgary Flames and Calgary Stampeders), embedding a sense of continuity and respect for our heritage.

Complementing this, the addition of blue symbolizes 'blue sky thinking'—a creative, imaginative approach that reflects the expansive Calgary skies that unite us. Yellow, evoking the sun, brings a touch of optimism, embodying Calgary's bright and promising future. Together, these colours—red, blue, and yellow—are not only primary colours that form the foundation for all other hues, but they also represent the diverse and powerful possibilities that define Calgary's identity as it steps into a new era.
