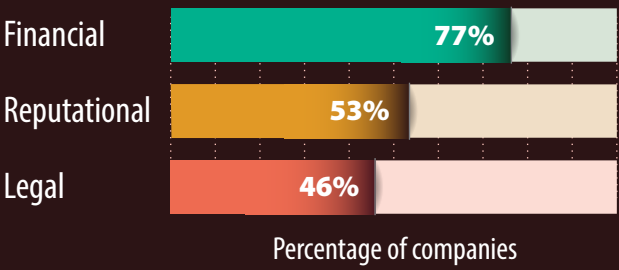

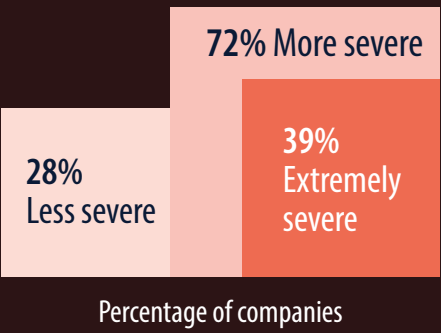
95% of companies have detected AI-related incidents

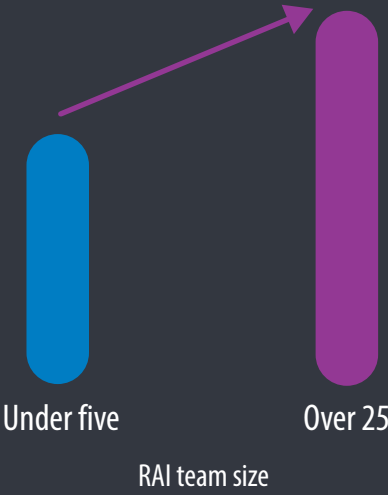

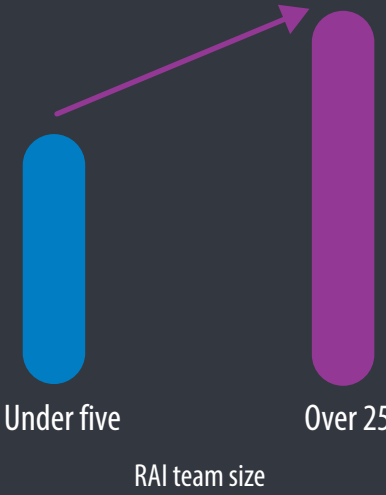

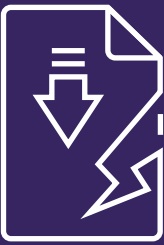
