Methodology

The N=400 survey was conducted among likely voters 10/13 through 10/19. The poll surveyed likely Southern Arizona General Election voters who have a history of electoral participation and was balanced to model the likely turnout of voters across party, age, region, and gender. No weighting has been applied. The live interview survey of voters was conducted by HighGround Public Affairs to both landline and cell phone users.




Dem: 40.2% - right direction GOP: 28.8% - right direction PND: 46.2% - right direction OTHER: 29.2% - right direction

In general, do you believe local government is doing enough to support local businesses and economic development in Southern Arizona?






What do you consider to be the top issue facing your area today?






