Mackenzie Health is home to the York Region Chronic Kidney Disease Program. The multi-site regional program – based at Mackenzie Richmond Hill Hospital with satellite sites providing ambulatory hemodialysis services in Oak Ridges and Vaughan – serves the entire region by providing the full continuum of chronic kidney disease services to admitted inpatients, as well as ambulatory outpatients.



A new Inpatient Dialysis Unit within the new Mackenzie Vaughan Hospital will support a unique model of care, new in Ontario, where treatment will be delivered through state-of-the-art dialysis stations within a unit designed exclusively for admitted inpatients.
