

This 1969 Bronco has been owned by the same family since new. Phil Falconer commissioned this Bronco to be rebuilt after it went virtually unchanged for 48 years. It was a 1-owner, 6-cylinder Bronco with original paint.

In fact, this was Phil's grandfather's Bronco. He and his grandfather used to go fishing on the Potomac River in this truck. For 25 years, Phil dreamed of restoring his grandfather's Bronco. In January 2017, Phil's journey to fulfill that dream started, and in January 2018, Phil's dream has come true. With over 50% new sheet metal and using the 351W engine from his father's Ford Station wagon, this Bronco is now breathing new life. 500 hp with Edelbrock Sequential EFI and Wilwood disc brakes.
