Phoenix Children's: Arizona's Only "Best Children's Hospital"

- The only American College of Surgeons-verified Level 1 Pediatric Trauma Center in Arizona and one of just a few in the U.S.
- The state's only Level IIIC Neonatal Intensive Care Unit and Neuro NICU
- Greater Phoenix's only Level 4 Pediatric Epilepsy Center, the highest level designated by the National Association of Epilepsy Centers
- Nationally ranked in 10 specialty areas by U.S. News & World Report, including Phoenix Children's Cardiology and Heart Surgery program (top 10 in the nation) and Pediatric Cancer program (top 20 in the nation)
- The Phoenix Valley's only Pediatric Cystic Fibrosis Center
- Three-star rating – the highest available – from the Society of Thoracic Surgeons, based on congenital cardiothoracic surgery outcomes data for the period from January 2014 through December 2017, one of only 12 Pediatric Heart programs in North America to receive three stars
