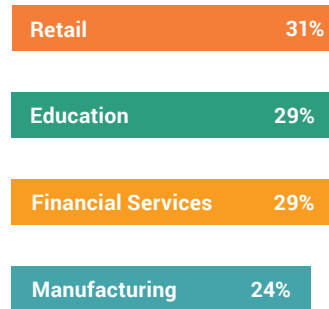
## HARDWARE-AS-A-SERVICE ADOPTION

**48%** of businesses currently lease one or more types of hardware

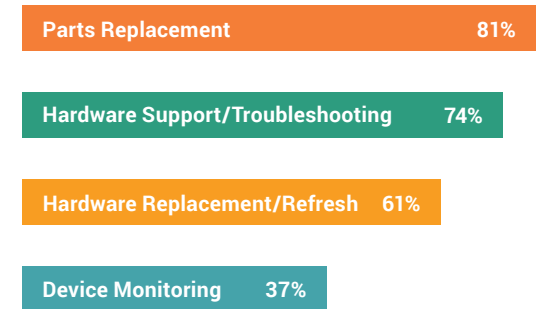
**24%** manage all leased hardware in-house

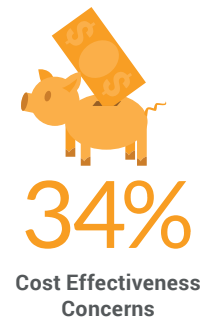
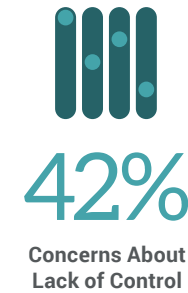
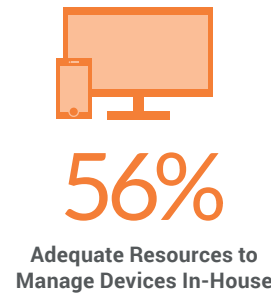


## BENEFITS VS. BARRIERS TO HAAS ADOPTION
